Establishing Higher Functioning Project Teams and Managing Resources

3 quarter units academic credit, X402.2; 30 PDU hours

Typically Offered: Fall, Spring

This course teaches you to identify, develop, communicate and manage a high-performance project team.

Mastering Project Time and Cost Management

4 quarter units academic credit, X455.39; 40 PDU hours

Typically Offered: Winter, Summer

Learn the tools and techniques for estimating activity durations, dependencies between activities and resource requirements. This course provides a detailed introduction to project time and cost management.

Navigating Project Procurement
